

EVENT DESCRIPTION


SDG 17, Partnerships for the Goals, prompts us to strengthen the means of implementation and revitalize global partnerships for sustainable development.

EVENT OBJECTIVES


The objectives of this event are to provide a technical briefing on the tools, strategies, and approaches presented and to offer resources on gender-responsiveness in partnerships for the goals.
