### High-level policy segment (10:30 - 13:00)

The 2023 Regional Forum will take place against the background of multiple crises. The High-level Policy Segment will take stock of the current status and shortcomings of SDG progress in the region. It will be informed by the UNECE Annual SDG Progress Report to be launched in early March 2023. A snapshot of SDG progress in the region will be provided at the beginning of the High-level Policy Segment to set the scene for the discussions. Thereafter, high-level government representatives will have an opportunity to share policy actions that have been taken domestically to preserve SDG progress and regain lost ground. Delegations may wish to particularly highlight measures of crisis response and how these can be effectively aligned with the 2030 Agenda. The High-level Policy Segment will also include reporting back from the preparatory civil society and youth consultations. Additionally, it may feature perspectives from other stakeholders, such as parliamentarians or the private sector.

**Plenary session (15:00 - 17:45)**

**Halfway towards 2030 – accelerating transformations to achieving the SDGs in the ECE region**

At the midpoint of the 2030 Agenda, the region is facing setbacks towards achieving the SDGs. Greater scale and momentum is needed to accelerate the full implementation of the SDGs in the remaining years until 2030. The second plenary session of the Regional Forum will therefore look ahead and identify the stakeholders and actions that will help drive progress. The discussion will take into account action areas and key messages from the peer learning round tables, which will be introduced at the outset by the Chair of the session.

The panel will attempt to highlight priority areas and explore innovative ideas for transformative action to achieve the SDGs in the region. The panel will comprise a member of the Independent Group of Scientists for the 2023 Global Sustainable Development Report (GSDR) and representatives from civil society/youth, the private sector and member States from different parts of the region – many of which are presenting Voluntary National Reviews in 2023.

Transformative action areas highlighted in the 2023 GSDR may inform the plenary debate following the panel discussion. In addition to forward-looking policy actions, member States and other stakeholders are particularly encouraged to share and announce high-impact initiatives that help preserve and accelerate SDG
