

Venue of the Regional Forum

The Forum will be held at the **E Building of Palais des Nations in Geneva, Rooms XIX, XXI and XVI** (8-14 avenue de la Paix, 1211 Geneva).

Receiving your digital badge and accessing the Palais des Nations:

Since September 2023, entry to the Palais des Nations is facilitated through a <u>digital badging</u> <u>system</u>. Participants receive a digital badge upon approval of their registration. They enter the Palais through the **Peace Gate** with their digital badge upon presentation of a valid passport or a national identity card. (Please note: delegates representing member States as well as international and observer organizations may optionally access the Palais through *Pregny Gate*).

Reaching the Palais des Nations

In Geneva, unireso public-transport tickets must be purchased prior to boarding a tram, bus or ferry. Ticket machines are available at most stops. Travel cards or passes can be purchased at the main TPG centres (Rive, Cornavin and Bachet de Pesay). Please note tickets are not available on the bus itself. Hotels, youth hostels or campsites typically offer a Geneva Transport Card, which allows use of public transport in Geneva free of charge during the period of stay.

Palais des Nations transit stops are **Appia** (for Pregny Gate) and **Nations** (for Peace Gate, see also <u>Nations station map</u>).

Access from Cornavin railway station (see also Cornavin station map):

- Bus lines 20, 60 and 61 ("Nations" or "Appia" stop), then a short walk to the gate
- Bus line 5 or tram line 15 ("Nations" stop)

Access from Cointrin airport:

• Bus line 5 ("Nations" stop)

Other bus lines with stop at "Nations":

• Bus lines 8, 11 and 22
