Gender Sensitive Parliaments: Inclusive Institutions	
Background and Rationale	

This side event seeks to explore the potential of gender sensitive parliaments for building effective accountable and inclusive institutions for all. 2024 is being described as a 'super election year' where a majority of eligible voters in the region will have an opportunity to cast a ballot. With the subsequent new convocations of legislative institutions, what more can parliaments do to advance gender equality? How can parliaments better provide equal opportunities for women and men to hold office, influence decision making processes, and produce gender sensitive legislation? The side event will align with the SDG 16.7 target to "Ensure responsive, inclusive, participatory and representative decision-making at all levels". The side event aims to highlight good work on gender sensitive parliaments in the region with both practical and aspirational examples from Parliaments and tools which Parliaments can use.

This interactive dialogue will be co-convened by UN Women with the European Institute for Gender Equality and the Inter-Parliamentary Union and will bring together key stakeholders from regional institutions, governments, parliaments, civil society, and academia.

Session objectives and expected outcomes

The side event aims to highlight good work on gender sensitive parliaments in the region with both practical and aspirational examples from Parliaments and tools which Parliaments can use. Panellists engage in a discussion during the thematic session relevant to building gender sensitive legislative institutions in the region. The panel aims to identify concrete recommendations, innovative solutions, and good practice tailored to the needs of the region that informs the sharing of good practice and further tailored policy solutions.
